I wanted to include these as Don kindly agreed to me sharing the high resolution images with you.

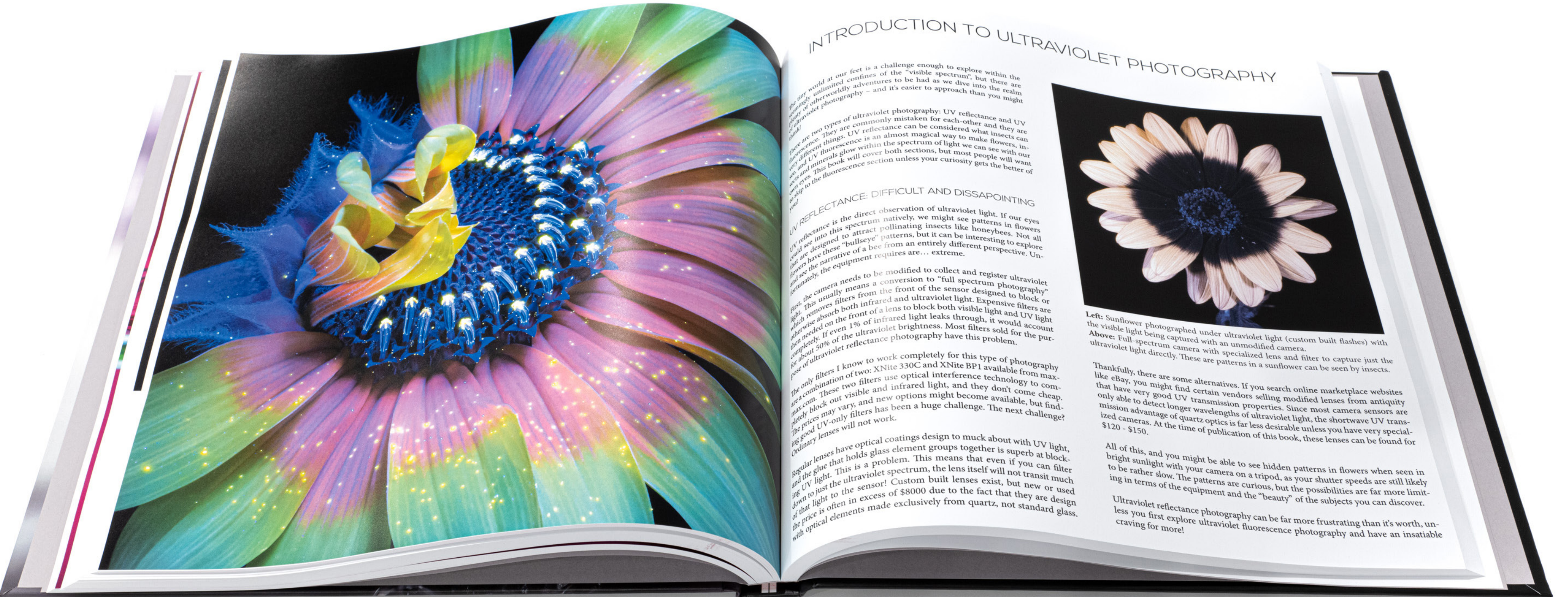
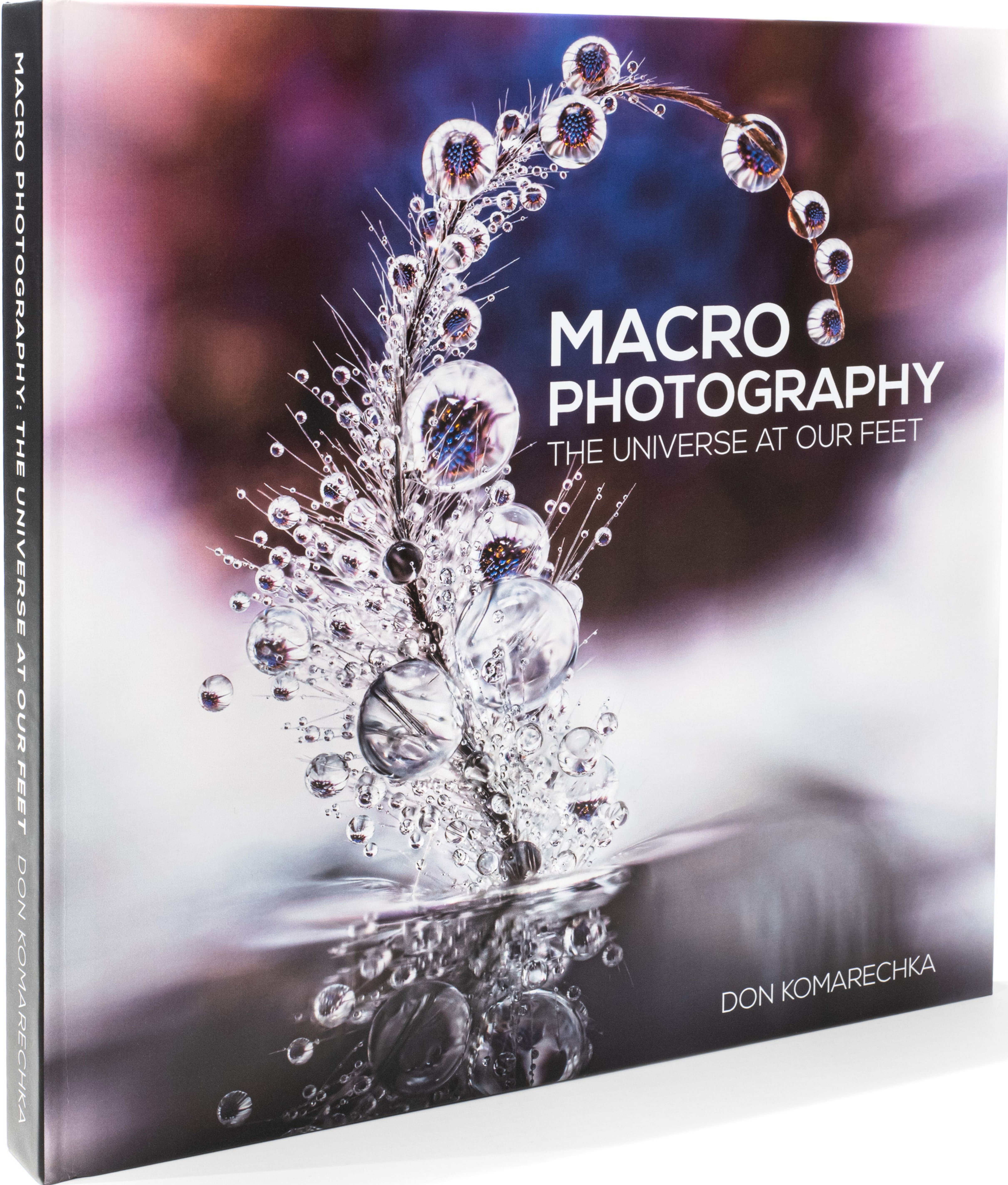
